were 15-21 years old.

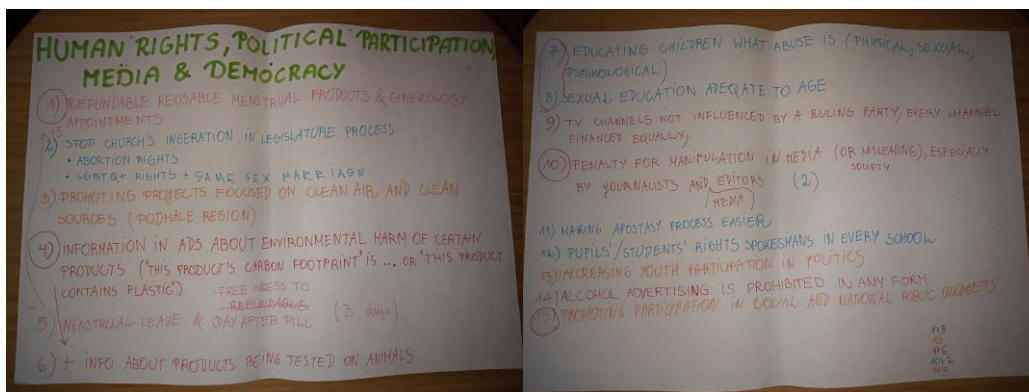
**During workshops in groups (world cafe method) young people worked in English on 7 topics.**

### ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, ANIMAL RIGHTS & CLIMATE CRISIS

Recruitment of students from all over the country  
 (don't forget to invite teachers)

**(Less-eco-friendly cities)**

- NO animal testing (ban for beauty companies)
- more national parks, green space
