Duration	3 hours
Age	15-25 years old
Methods	Trekking
Materials	Pen and paper, a smartphone.
Competences	Critical thinking, knowledge of historical places of resistance, oratory skills, research skill, creativity.
Aims	Introducing young people to places of resistance by having them explore their own city and connect them among past and the future
Source	We World
Procedure description	<p>Groups of youth/students should prepare an itinerary on places in their city (or a city of their choice) related to the Resistance, also involving dedicated museums and institutes. Through research, a map with descriptions of points of interest is created.</p> <p>Therefore, the workshop is divided into two parts (and at least two days). Firstly, they have to do a little research on the monuments/places of interest of the resistance in the chosen city. This can be done precisely by collaborating with local museums and associations related to the partisan and historical world.</p> <p>After that, the youth themselves must implement the tour by involving citizens, acting as guides of the chosen areas. In this way the participants develop both research skills and independence in handling events.</p> <p>Trainers need to follow the boys, help them in the development of the activity and facilitate dialogues between them and the various associations but also leave a degree of creativity.</p>
