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

## Political positioning 1: Regulate to facilitate the (agrarian) extractivist project


 Financialized investment capital and corporations, some global governance institutions (World Bank, etc.); some governments from the global north and the global south

# Political positioning 2: Regulate to mitigate negative impacts and maximize benefits of the (agrarian) extractivist project

The "middle-ground" position: some global governance institutions (FAO, etc.); some governments from the global north and the global south, most big international development and environmental NGOs, especially those in:



# Political positioning 3: Regulate to stop and roll-back the (agrarian) extractivist project, to push for an alternative life project



### Food sovereignty and democratic land control

From technocratic 'land governance', to 'democratic land control' or 'land sovereignty': the right of the working peoples, rural and urban, to have effective access to, control over and use of land, and live on it as a resource, space and territory.
