During workshops in groups (world cafe method) young people worked in English on 7 topics.











Youth worked in groups on 7 issues. We used the world coffee method. Every 15 minutes they changed the tea table:

Young people had the opportunity to choose a creative form through which they wanted to present selected demands.










The choices were graphics/comic book, video, music/song, dance/performance.
