

Problem: fragmented pilots, no unified voice for e-mobility.

## THE SPARK: FROM IDEA TO INSTITUTION



Response: Create an association to convene startups, OEMs, utilities, financiers, academia.



Mission: make e-mobility bankable, visible, and scalable.



Lesson: every revolution needs an institutional home.



I) Define the gap: policy, standards, skills, finance.

2) Governance: board, secretariat, technical committees, youth chapter.



3) Legitimacy: legal registration, MoUs, codes of conduct for members.



4) Early wins: policy briefs, standardization input, visible pilots.




5) Data: publish market baselines and TCO tools to guide decisions.




POLICY &
STANDARDS: WHAT
SUCCESS LOOKS LIKE

- VAT zero-rating on e-bicycles (Finance Act 2023) as a catalytic signal.
- Draft national e-mobility policy & EV charging standards underway.
- Harmonize across corridors (AfCFTA) to unlock scale and lower risk.
- Anchor with data: safety, interoperability, lifecycle, recycling



### THE ECOSYSTEM IN MOTION





Lower TCO: fuel + maintenance savings over lifecycle.

## WHY IT MATTERS FOR BUSINESS



New value chains: assembly, charging, analytics, battery second life.



Bankable demand: fleets (logistics, buses) + corridor freight electrification.



ESG & brand: early movers win tenders, investors, customers.





# WHY IT MATTERS FOR GOVERNM ENT

ENERGY SECURITY: REDUCED FUEL-IMPORT EXPOSURE, FOREX STABILITY. JOBS & SKILLS:TECHNICIANS, DRIVERS, SOFTWARE, RECYCLING—FORMAL & MSME.



CLEANER CITIES: BETTER AIR QUALITY & PRODUCTIVITY, LOWER HEALTH COSTS.



NDC DELIVERY:TRANSPORT ELECTRIFICATION AS A NAMED MITIGATION MEASURE.

### CALL TO ACTION: BUSINESS & GOVERNMENT

- BUSINESS: co-invest in charging, training, data; join the association; pilot fleets.
- GOVERNMENT: lock in incentives & standards; enable corridor harmonization.
- JOINTLY: publish shared data; design blended finance for scale.
- Not just vehicles, but vision—let's move Africa forward, together.
